Native American Project

Directions: You get to create a model of a Native American cultural region home that we have studied in class. Choose from one of the following groups: **Eastern Woodlands, Plains, Southwest Desert, Great Basin, Pacific Northwest, or Arctic.**

Your model should include the following:

1. Type of land and vegetation
 2. Type of home where the Native Americans would have lived in the region you choose.
 3. People/Animals of the region
 4. Optional: tools, boats, clothes
- **As many things as possible should be made by hand and not store bought figures**

You will also need to write or type one to two paragraphs including:

1. The tribes, specifically named, in this region
 2. What they did in their everyday life to hunt, survive, or for fun
 3. The environment and the type of land and homes they lived in.
- **This will be turned in with your diorama.**

You will be explaining your project to the class so be sure you know what you are going to say!

Rubric:

Project: Your project should be neat and represent your Native American cultural region accurately. Your project should be your own work. Please try not to spend too much money on this project. Try to use supplies from around your house.

_____ 30 points

Writing: Your writing should be neat and free of spelling and punctuation errors. Your sentences should be complete and make sense. Your teacher will be looking for facts about your region. Be sure to write it in your own words and not just copy from a book or website. Your writing should include the tribes in this region, what they do in their everyday life and the type of land and homes they live in.

Speaking and listening: Practice your presentation before the due date. You will be graded on ability to make eye contact, speak loudly and clearly, and stand where the audience can see you and your project. You should be a good listener and ask interesting questions.
